It has become increasingly apparent to the official's at the Amazing Grace Foundation, that a boy, now a man, with such an incredible approach to life should be able to share and communicate it with the world. However without a voice box, we will never have an opportunity to hear from him; Kevorn will never be able to speak. We take it for granted that we have the ability to speak. And in some cases, we may even waste our gifts expressing in a loveless manner.
